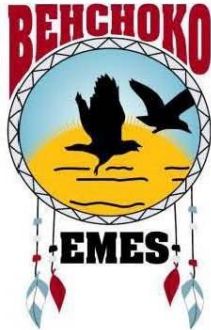

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EMES Safe School Policy

The Elizabeth Mackenzie Elementary School safe school policy is two-fold consisting of positive reinforcement and developing strong self-regulation skills in the following areas: Physical, Emotional, Behavioural, Social and Academic. The aim of our Safe School Plan is to foster a safe and effective learning environment at EMES. Every student and staff member at EMES has the right to learn and work in a safe environment that is conducive to the learning process. School administration maintains a Safe School policy at EMES that strives to establish an environment where both students and staff are safe from physical and emotional harm as well as being able to work and learn in an environment that supports learning. At EMES this goal is accomplished in compliance with the duties of a principal as prescribed under the Education Act as follows:

- To ensure students understand the school rules, code of conduct and consequences, Ed Act (45)(1)(h)(i)(j);
- To keep parents informed of students' behaviour, Ed Act (45)(1)(h)(i);
- To develop a positive learning environment, Ed Act (69)(2)(j);
- To ensure to the best of one's ability the safety of all students and staff, Ed Act (69)(2)(k); and
- To ensure bullying prevention, intervention and education strategies that are evidence based and target the entire learning community, Safe and Caring Schools Regulations (2)(5)(a-e).
