MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between:

The Tłįcho Government, (herein represented by the Grand Chief) hereinafter referred to as the "Tłįcho Government"

And:

The Government of the Northwest Territories, (herein represented by the Minister of Education, Culture and Employment) hereinafter referred to as "ECE"

And:

The Tłįcho Community Services Agency, (herein represented by the Chairperson of the Board of the Tłįcho Community Services Agency) hereinafter referred to as "TCSA"

Whereas on June 29, 2012, the Tłįcho Government and the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) signed the Tłįcho Government/GNWT Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding;

And Whereas the GNWT has committed to work with the Tłįchǫ Government to formalize shared facilities arrangements for early childhood and social wellness programs with Kindergarten to Grade 12 school programs;

And Whereas education bodies should enter into agreements that provide for the maximum possible use of education facilities;

And Whereas the parties wish to formalize this agreement;

Now Therefore, this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) outlines the parameters of the agreement and bears witness to the fact that the parties agree on the terms and conditions hereinafter:

The parties understand the following parameters and conditions:

1. Purpose of the MOU

1.1 This MOU establishes an agreement and a cooperative working relationship between ECE, the Tłįchǫ Government and the TCSA to

formalize a shared facilities arrangement for early childhood and social wellness programs and Kindergarten to Grade 12 school programs.

2. Conditions

- 2.1 The TCSA should enter into use/rental/lease arrangements with the Tłįcho Government for use of existing facilities under their jurisdiction without the need for transfer of funds from one party to the other when such arrangements:
 - a) are in the best interests of the students, and
 - b) do not interfere with the regular delivery or space requirements of Kindergarten to Grade 12 programs.
- 2.2 When the TCSA has entered into use/rental/lease arrangements with the Tłįcho Government, such arrangements should only be terminated if the dispute resolution processes set out in section 3 of this MOU have been followed.

3. Dispute Resolution

- 3.1 Those parties initially involved in a dispute will first attempt to resolve it themselves. Disputes that continue will be handled as follows:
 - **Level 1**: Chair of the local education body, school principal and Manager of Early Childhood Programs and/or Manager of Social/Wellness Programs.
 - Level 2: Tłįcho Government Representative and TCSA representative.

4. Term

- 4.1 The terms of this MOU shall start as of the date of signing of this Agreement and shall remain until one of the Parties terminates the Agreement.
- 4.2 This MOU may be terminated by either party upon written notice to the other two parties and at least 60 written days' notice of its intention to terminate.
- 4.3 This MOU may be amended by mutual agreement in writing between the Parties hereto.

5. Effect of the MOU

- 5.1 Nothing in this MOU creates legal obligations.
- 5.2 Nothing in this MOU shall constrain the respective governments from exercising their powers and responsibilities, nor impose any financial obligation.
- 5.3 Nothing in this MOU prevents the Tłįcho Government, the TCSA and the GNWT from participating in other intergovernmental processes or agreements.
