Student Travel Policy

School related travel is a privilege and a reward to those students who have demonstrated a positive standard of behavior, attendance, and academics. On school trips, participants are considered representatives of the school and are expected to be positive members of the school community.

To be considered eligible to participate in school travel students must:

- be respectful towards the school, their peers, and all members of staff;
- be responsible for all missed schoolwork during their absence;

Please note that:

- the eligibility status of students with office referrals or infractions will be evaluated at the discretion of the principal;
- > any fundraising required to finance the school trip is the responsibility of students and/or parents;
- if students do not take part in the fundraising, parents/guardians will be responsible for the full financial costs incurred by their child's participation;
- money that has been fundraised for the trip will support the travel of all students, not individual students, and is not reimbursable to individuals;
- other factors which may influence a student's eligibility to travel includes, but is not limited to, attendance, academic achievement, behavior, etc.

Students approved to travel remains at the principal's discretion. If your child is not permitted to travel on a school trip, you will be notified by the school principal in advance.

- respect the rights and beliefs of all others attending the event.
